○	Spelling error
!	You are hyperbolizing --> Don't use words like ALL or NONE [absolutes].
?	Wrong word used, incorrect use of a word, OR I don't understand what you are trying to say.
a. ph.	Awkwardly-phrased → poor grammar.
c. c.	Comma "crazy"
(con)	Connection → the idea in the previous sentence does not connect with the idea in the sentence that follows
EX!	Exaggeration. Don't hyperbolize!
g.	Good
g. o. i	Good [use of] outside information
g. u. doc.	Good use [of the] document(s)
L. L.	"Laundry list" of items/ideas. Express them in at least two separate sentences
N-A-S	Not a sentence
P. R.	Proof-read → please proof-read your entire essay and make final corrections before printing out a good copy to hand in to me for a grade!
p. t. v.	Use past-tense verbs → after all, you are writing about past events
rep.	Repetitious word, or phrase
R-O-S	Run-on sentence
s. b. s.	Short, "baby" sentences (4-6 words each or so in length)
s. c. ¶	Strong concluding paragraph
s. i. ¶	Strong introductory paragraph
s. t. l.	Sentence is TOO long, too complex.
u. c.	Unclear → what are you trying to say here?
v. g.	Very good
v. g. pt.	Very good point made
w. c. ¶	Weak concluding paragraph
w. i. ¶	Weak introductory paragraph
